

GPFA 30th Anniversary Contest Shoe List

October 1st 2010 Athens GA

Div. I

- Eagle Eye** 30 min
- Front pattern shoe shaped to hind foot with trailer, quarter clipped
- Class 1** 60 min
- 3 hind pattern shoes shaped to fit a front pattern
- 1 with rolled toe and nail hole (appropriate nail)
- 1 with rocker toe fullered through the toe
- 1 with toe clip and pad finished as if on the foot
- Class 2** 60 min
- shoe two front feet with hind pattern keg shoes with hammer drawn toe clips
- (All Div. I competitors will have the heel of their anvil tapped up and will only be allowed to use the horn and the face of their anvils.)*

Div. II

- Eagle Eye** 30 min
- 3/8" x 3/4", 3/4 fullered Straight bar punched for appropriate nail
- Class I** 60 min
- 60" x 3/8" x 3/4" , barstock must be cut at the anvil, no shears, band saws, or chop saws. Will not be allowed to cut stock before the class begins
- Pair plain stamped fronts, hammer drawn toe clips, punched for appropriate nail
- Pair plain stamped hinds, bob punched quarter clips, punched for appropriated nail, safed toe, obvious inside and outside branches.
- Shoes will be built to fit patterns, fit will be judges choice (A, B, or C AFA Fit)
- Class 2** 60 min
- Shoe two hind feet with 3/4 fullered shoes, with safed toe, and obvious inside and outside branches, quarter clipped.

Div. Open

- Eagle eye** 30 min
- Heart Bar, 3/8" x 3/4", fullered, punched for appropriate nail
- Class 1** 60 min
- Pair of Side bone shoes, 11 1/2" 3/8" x 3/4", outside plain stamped 2 nails, inside four nails fullered, punched for MX60
- Class 2** 60 min
- Roadster 1/2" X 1" X 11" plain stamped, Caulk and wedge, with a bumped up toe and a toe clip, punched for E6.
- French hind, 11 1/2" X 3/8" X 1" with a square toe and masselotte clips (not drawn) fullered, punched for 6 nails 5city. Inside running wedge and outside caulk

Two Man

- Partners will be drawn. Div. I and Open competitors will be paired together and Div. II competitors will be be paired together.
- Shoe or shoes will be judges choice and demonstrated on site before the class begins
